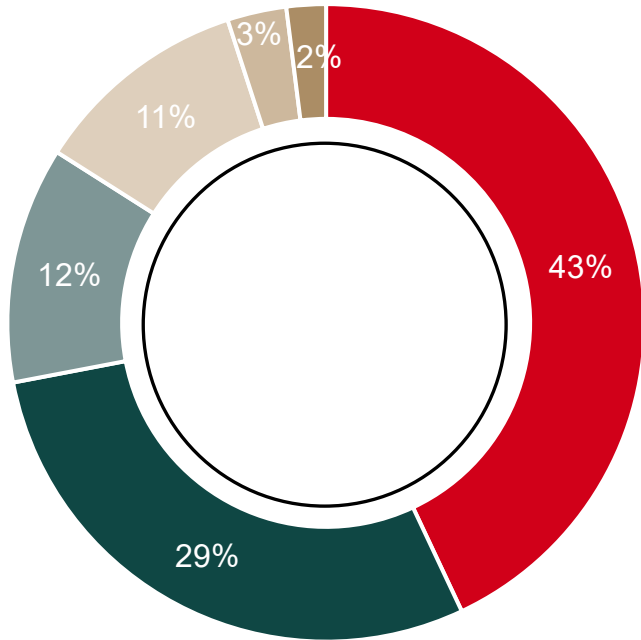

Sector comparison in %

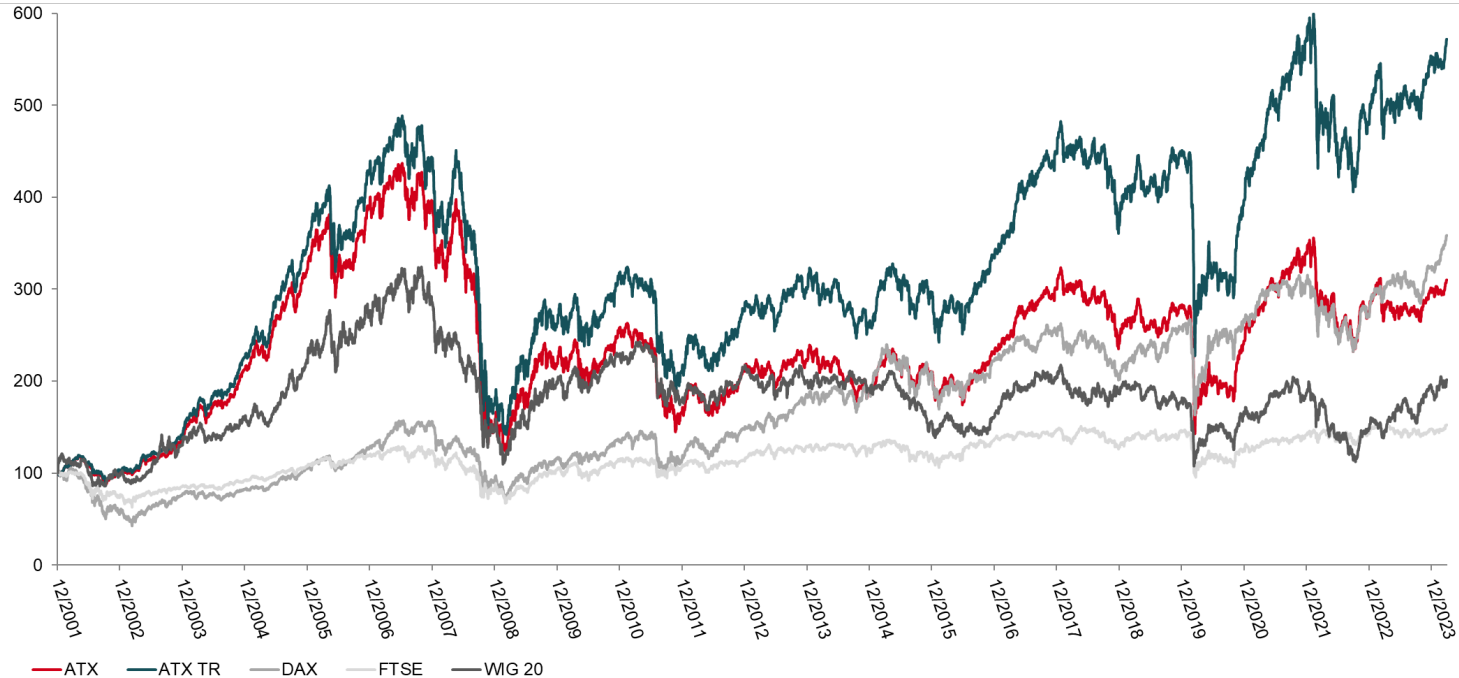

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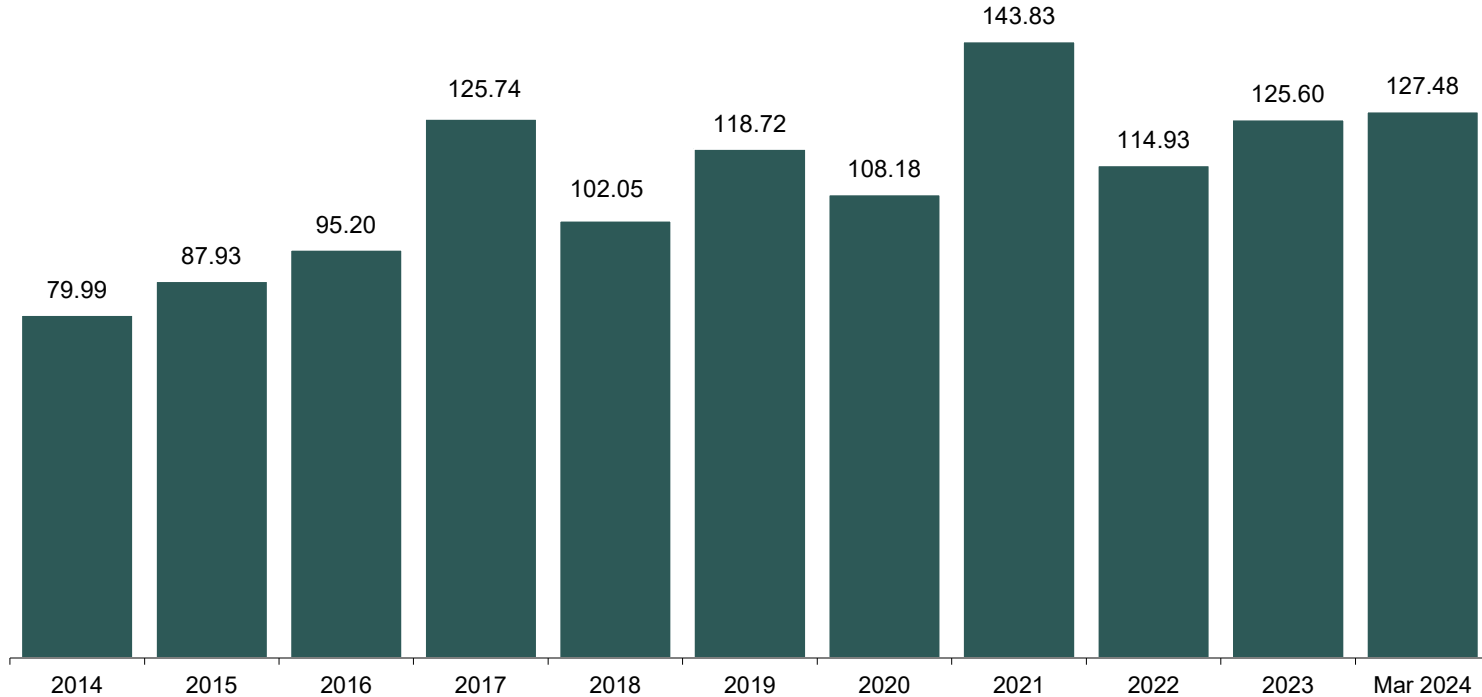
# Investing is a marathon, not a sprint

in EUR billion



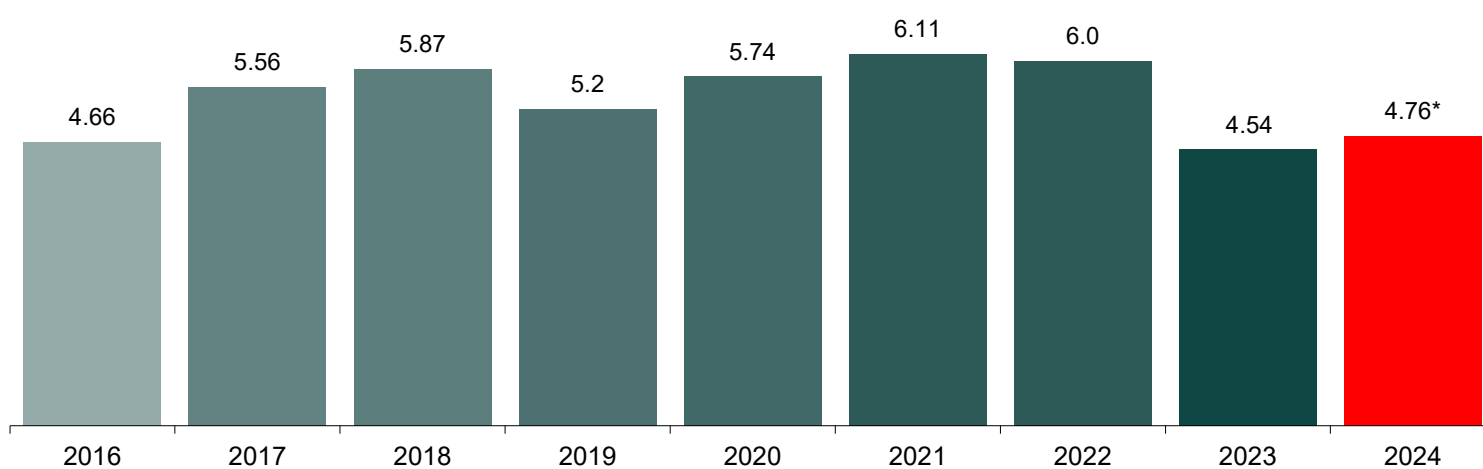

# Average monthly turnover

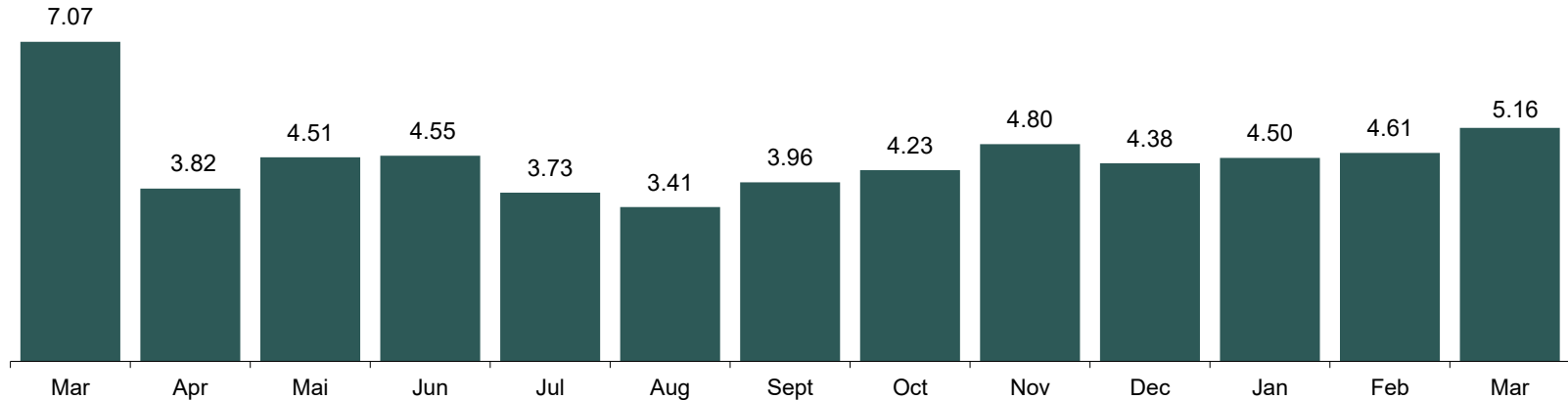
in EUR bn

in EUR bn



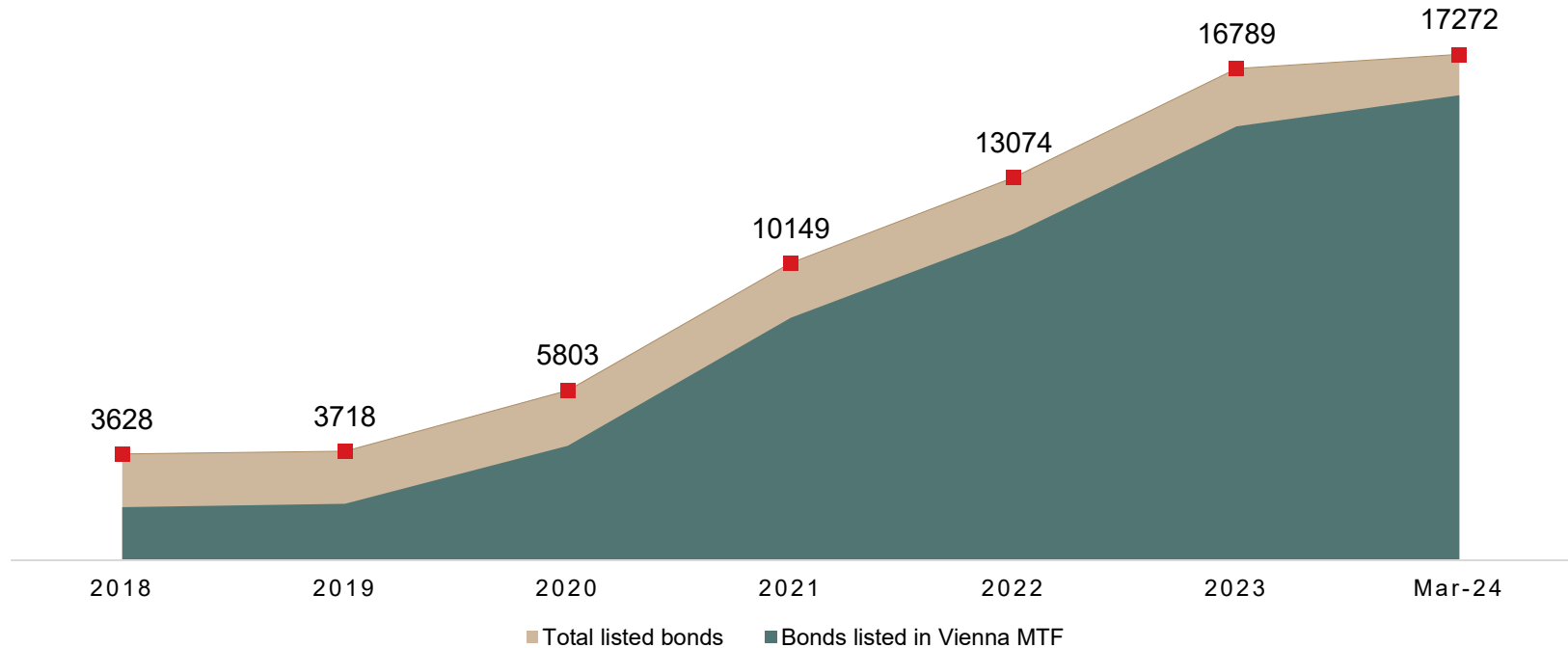

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# Vienna Stock Exchange: Bond listings at a high level

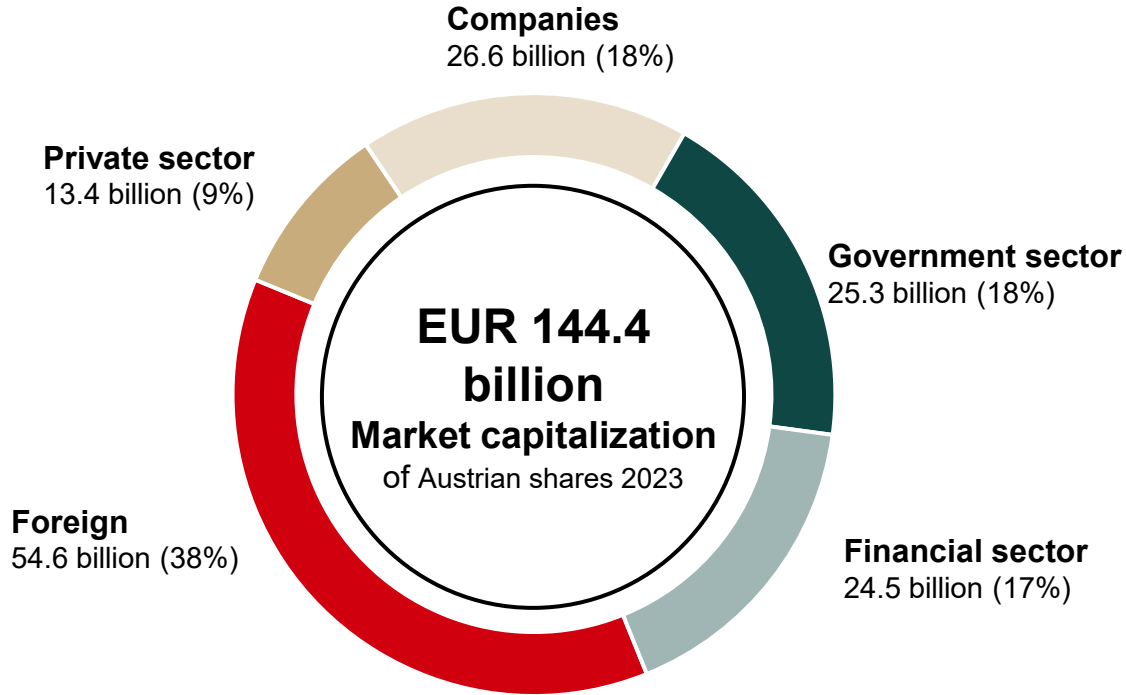
Number of listings 2018 – March 2024

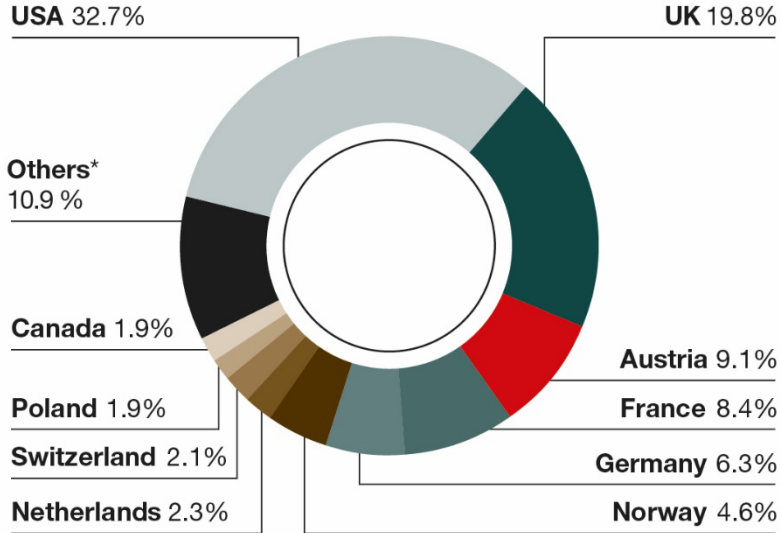


# Foreign investors dominate ownership of Austrian listed shares
